## CATEGORIES OF NATIONAL HONOURS AWARDS

There are three categories of National Honours Awards in order of precedence as follows:

- the "Order of National Hero" may be awarded to any citizen who has rendered distinguished and outstanding service to the Nation;
- the "Star of Merit" may be awarded for long and meritorious service, or for loyal and devoted service to the Nation;
- the "Medal of Honour" may be awarded for outstanding and meritorious service to the Nation.

## HOW AWARDS ARE MADE

Nominations are made for National Honours Awards by members of the Public and/or Organizations to the National Honours Awards Committee.

The National Honours Awards Committee considers these recommendations and forwards its recommendations to the Prime Minister.

The Prime Minister considers these recommendations and he advises the Governor-General thereof and of his own recommendations if any.

The Governor-General makes the award on the advice of the Prime Minister, and with the consent of the nominee.
